Continue with Read Write Inc phonics programme
Reading and discussing 'river stories' and myths and fables from ancient Egypt.
Continue to work on composing a sentence orally before writing, remembering to include finger spaces and full stops adding in some common exception words, question marks and explanation marks
To know how to use lower case and capital letters within writing, being able to identify letter names as well as sounds
To know how to form lowercase letters in the correct direction as well as capital letters
Begin to sequence simple sentences to form short narratives
Spelling practice (Year 1) practicing division of words into syllables and looking at word endings
Write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher, including common exception words.
