|  <p>Pharaoh</p> | <p><u>Pharaohs</u></p> <p>Pharaohs were the king or queen of Egypt. They owned everything in Egypt and decided how the country was run. They were the most rich and powerful people in Egypt.</p> |
|  | <p><u>Viziers</u></p> <p>Viziers were extremely powerful. They helped pharaohs run the country and acted as judges in the high court. They had to speak to the pharaoh for the other officials.</p> |
|  | <p><u>Priests</u></p> <p>Priests were responsible for keeping the gods happy. They spent their time performing rituals and ceremonies in the temples. They didn't preach to people.</p> |
|  | <p><u>Nobles</u></p> <p>Nobles ran the different areas of Egypt. They made and enforced local laws. Being a noble was hereditary- the job was passed down in families.</p> |
|  | <p><u>Scribes</u></p> <p>Scribes were very important because they were the only people who could read and write. They kept records, using hieroglyphics, about the things that happened in Egypt. This job was also passed down in families too.</p> |
