<p>Draw a treasure map! This can be completely made up, but needs to show part of a journey over the sea!</p> <p>LO: I know that a map is an aerial view. I can draw a map. I can even remember to use some symbols to represent features on land and sea.</p>	<p>Research the sorts of food which are important to take on sea voyages. Are there any foods which are difficult to transport?</p> <p>LO: I know it is important to stay healthy when on a voyage. I can name and write about foods which my body will need to stay healthy.</p>	<p>In the past sailors brought new foods to Britain. Can you name and draw three?</p> <p>LO: I know not all foods we eat now originally come from Britain. I can name three (or more) foods which were brought to this country in the past. I can even say when they were brought here.</p>
<p>What would your 'seafarer's name be? (It could be a pirate name, if you want!) Draw yourself and what you would wear if you were going to sea in the past around 3 hundred years ago!</p> <p>LO: I know how to label a diagram. I can even explain why I have drawn certain things on my picture.</p>	<p>Make a junk model boat for a boat race. This will need to be in before <b><u>Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> May.</u></b></p> <p>LO: I know which materials float. I can make a small boat which can float and be blown across a water bath. *please do not make it longer than 30cm as it will be tricky to make it 'race'!</p>
