	golden sandals	There were left so the Pharaoh could wear them in the afterlife.
	large shields	These were left to show that Tutankhamun was a brave ruler.
	grand throne	Tutankhamun would have sat on this.
	folding stool	This was gifted to Tutankhamun from a prince from Nubia.

	<p>Anubis</p> <p>sitting</p>	<p>This was used in the funeral procession and left to watch over and guard the Pharaoh.</p>
	<p>death mask</p> <p>heavy</p>	<p>This was placed on Tutankhamun's head in the sarcophagus.</p>
	<p>canopic heads</p> <p>alabaster</p>	<p>They were lids for the Canopic jars which held the internal organs of the pharaoh.</p>
	<p>large</p> <p>sarcophagus</p>	<p>Tutankhamun's body was placed in three coffins. This is the middle one.</p>
	<p>scarab brooch</p> <p>decorated</p>	<p>This was left for Tutankhamun to wear in the afterlife.</p>
	<p>ornate</p> <p>canopic shrine</p>	<p>All of the Pharaoh's internal organs were placed in here so they would be safe.</p>
