Dear Parents and Carers

We hope this letter finds you well. We have been working really hard to try and accommodate as many children back into school as possible before the end of term. After much deliberation, we have decided to invite all remaining year groups, starting the 29th June. This new timetable will be in place until the 17th July / end of term.

Moving forward this will mean changes to our current bubbles and drop off and collection times may vary from the current ones. We will ensure all areas of school are thoroughly cleaned before the implementation of the new bubbles, but please be aware it will mean some children will have to swap from the class they currently work in, in order for this new rota to go ahead. We currently have designated desks, resources and stationery for each child, this will continue to help prevent any cross contamination.

WE ARE SORRY TO SAY WE HAVE BASED OUR ROTAS ON THOSE PARENTS WHO SAID THEY WANTED THEIR CHILDREN TO RETURN. WE ARE NOW AT FULL CAPACITY AND THEREFORE WE HAVE NO SPACE FOR CHILDREN WHO SAID THEY WERE NOT RETURNING THIS TERM.

In line with government guidance, we cannot allow parents into school, so please call the school office if you have any enquiries throughout the day.

Can we remind everybody that children are only required to bring a lunch box and drink bottle, no school bags please. Kingswood are providing daily packed lunches, if you require this service please log in to your account to order directly. Government advice is for a new, clean uniform each day. If you need to send your child into school, on the odd occasion, in normal clothing whilst their uniform is being washed, this is absolutely fine.

We currently have an enhanced cleaning procedure throughout the school, this includes the following additional measures, on top of the 3 hours deep clean happening every evening with our cleaning company:

- Regular cleaning of table tops, chairs, door handles and other classroom surfaces that children have access to
- All main internal doors are kept propped open and windows are open, to allow fresh air ventilation into all areas for the school
- Taps and sinks are regularly checked and cleaned as necessary throughout the day
- All learning equipment is disinfected overnight in a high grade disinfectant
- Hand washing routines are maintained as per current procedure
- We also have a high grade sterilising spray to be used in the classrooms
