Getting Started

- Watch the video to familiarise yourself with the sounds and most importantly the correct pronunciation of sounds. Sound pronunciation Videos: <https://www.ruthmiskin.com/en/find-out-more/parents/#lg=1&slide=2>

- look in your child's sound book and see if they familiar with all set one sounds

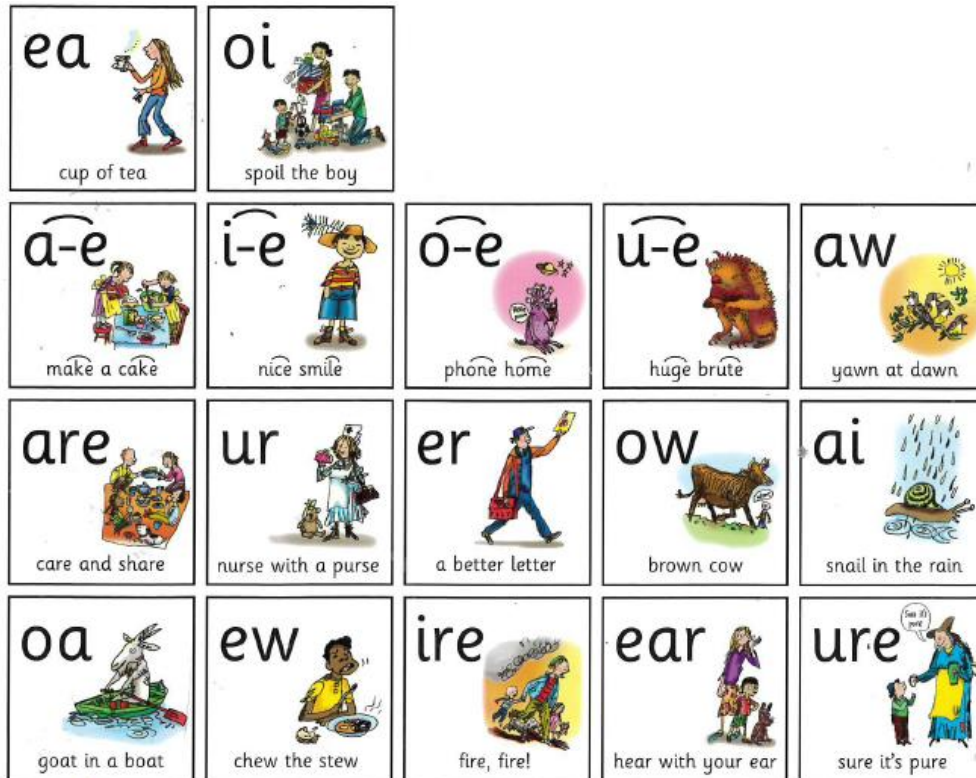


If your child needs to refresh some of the set 1 sounds this is a great place to start.

- If secure in set 1 now is the time to move onto set 2, again familiarise yourself and your child with the sounds



-For those children (or parents)who need an extra challenge there is always Set 3'



What does a home phonics lesson look like:

Firstly get your child to call out all of the sounds in set 1 and set 2 to you, we call these are speed sounds as they should be done quickly and precisely. If your child stumbles upon a sound make a note of it and revisit.

Set 1 Speed sounds chart

Set 2 and 3 speed sounds chart

- Next focus on a sound, for most children this will be a sound within set 2 (for this purpose I shall use 'ay' as an example)
- say the sound and get your child to repeat, then look at the picture next to the sound and discuss
- say the phrase 'ay may i play'
- now it is time to look at words that incorporate the learnt sound

Download set 2 sounds - corresponding words (or set 3)

- finally recap red (tricky words that cannot be sounded out and have to be learnt visually) and green words (which can be sounded out). This is where I would suggest you start at the beginning and get a feel for what your child already knows and what they need to learn going forward.

Red Words 1-3

Green Words 1-7

Handwriting - choose a couple of letters for your child to practice writing along with the corresponding phrase
