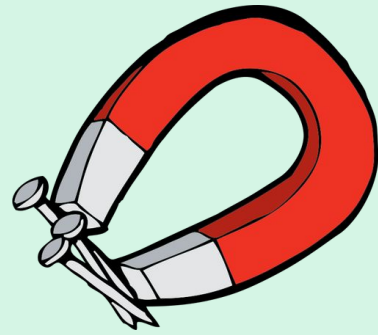

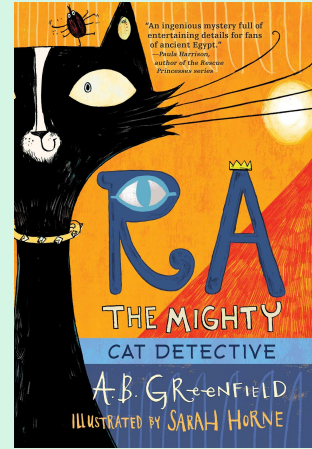
Why are magnets different shapes?
